# John 15:1-17 With Interim Pastor Dewayne Lebow

What is the fruit that God wants us to bear?

1. Romans  $1:13^1$  -- Spiritual Impact in the lives of others.

<sup>13</sup> I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that often I have planned to come to you (and have been prevented so far) so that I may obtain some fruit among you also, even as among the rest of the Gentiles.

#### 2. Romans 6:22 - Practical Holiness.

<sup>22</sup> But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life.

### 3. Romans 15:28 - Giving & Sharing.

<sup>28</sup> Therefore, when I have finished this, and have put my seal on this fruit of theirs, I will go on by way of you to Spain.

### 4. Galatians 5: 22, 23 -- Holy Spirit produced qualities/attitudes.

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

### 5. Colossians 1: 10 - A life of good works empowered by the Holy Spirit.

<sup>10</sup> so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

6. Hebrews 13:15 - Our words of Thanks & Praises to God.

#### **God-pleasing Sacrifices**

<sup>15</sup> Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.
