

## Introduction:

Due to the Calvinistic theology that is obviously present in the 1689 Baptist Confession of Faith (EG 2:1; 2:2; 3:3; 3:6; 5:5; 6:4; 8:5; 8:6; 8:8), we spent a brief time highlighting the traditional five points of Calvinist's doctrine:

**T** – Total depravity of man – Ps. 51:5; Matt. 7:17-18; 13:14; Jn. 6:44; Rom. 3:11; 23

**U** – Unconditional election – Rom. 8:29-30; 9:10-14; Eph. 1:4-11

**L** – Limited atonement – (We would say that it is limited in its application, but not it's availability.) I Jn. 2:2

**I** – Irresistible grace – Eph. 1:7; 2:8-9; Rom. 5:15-17

**P** – Preservation of the saints – Jn. 10:27-29; Rom. 8:29-30; Eph. 1:3-14

## Conclusion:

Man has no active participation in his own salvation. He is passive.

God is the only active participant in our salvation.

You aren't saved because you want to be saved. You aren't saved because you believe the components of the gospel. You aren't saved by any effort or work you do.

You are saved because God saved you.
